

# **2016-17 FEES INFORMATION**Full Time Undergraduate Programmes

These fees apply to our full time undergraduate programmes, as detailed below.

# **Full time Undergraduate Programmes**

- 1 year, CertHE: Certificate of Higher Education in Theology
- 2 years, FdA: Foundation Degree in Arts in Theology
- 3 years, BA (Hons): Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Theology
- 4 Years, MTheol\*: Master in Theology in Theology

For the CertHE, FdA and BA (Hons), each student specialises in one of three streams:

- Theological and Pastoral Studies (TPS)
- Theology for Crossing Cultures (TCC)
- Theology and Praxis for Children's and Youth Ministry (TCY)

# Fees 2016/17

Fees for full time students for the 2016/17 academic year are as below. Fees are payable each year; normally, there is an increase in fees of approximately 3-5% each year.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Typically, college rental prices are approximately 70% of the local commercial rental rate. To maintain this, College reserves the right to increase rental charges each year within a range of 3%-10%.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>The tuition fee includes:

- Library and VLE facilities
- Study facilities
- Internet access in the Academic Centre, all rooms and flats in the Main Building and all single accommodation
- Meals during term time as follows
  - Single students: the fee includes breakfast and lunch each weekday during term time, and an allowance for evenings and weekends in the form of a minimal termly rehate
  - Married students: the fee includes lunch each weekday during term time

<sup>2</sup>Oak Hill College is an Associate College of Middlesex University. Its validated programmes have been developed, are delivered and assessed by the College; they are awarded and quality assured by Middlesex University. This means that our students are liable for registration fees. The registration fee is payable for two years of study on each programme. In practice, this normally means it is payable for:

- The first year of the CertHE
- The first and second year of the FdA
- The first and second year of the BA (Hons)
- N.B. Students who complete a qualification and then decide to enrol for further study on a higher qualification may incur a further registration fee

## **Church of England Ordinands**

Candidates accepted for ordination training by the Church of England will normally have their tuition covered by Ministry Division and an allowance for accommodation by their sponsoring diocese. Candidates are advised to speak with their Diocesan Director of Ordinands (DDO) for information.

## When are fees payable?

- Tuition fees
  - bills are issued after the start of the academic year and tuition fees are normally payable in two instalments in October and February
- College-owned accommodation
  - o married students pay rent on a monthly basis
  - single students in term-time accommodation are billed for tuition and accommodation at the same time and the bill may be paid in two instalments in October and February
  - single students in 52 week accommodation receive a bill for tuition and term-time accommodation that is payable in October and February. The additional amount for 52 week accommodation (£1589) is payable in three instalments at the start of each vacation period

### **Study Options for spouses of full time students**

- Spouses of full time students who also wish to study full time will be charged the normal full time fees
- Spouses of full time students who wish to study part time on an award programme will be charged half price for each module, and full price for the registration fee
- Spouses of full time students may credit modules for half price and audit modules at no charge
- For any full time study, part time study or crediting of individual modules, spouses need to apply separately and by the usual closing dates for receiving applications; registering for spouse auditing may be done just before or once at college
