

These fees apply to our part time undergraduate programmes, as detailed below.

### Part time Undergraduate Programmes

- CertHE, part time over 2 years: Certificate of Higher Education in Theology
- FdA, part time over 4 years: Foundation Degree in Arts in Theology
- BA (Hons), part time over 6 years: Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Theology

For the CertHE, FdA and BA (Hons), each student specialises in one of three streams:

- Theological and Pastoral Studies (TPS)
- Theology for Crossing Cultures (TCC)
- Theology and Praxis for Children's and Youth Ministry (TCY)

### Part Time Study

Part time students on undergraduate programmes at Oak Hill follow exactly the same academic programme as full time students, but take at least twice as long to complete their qualification. For each programme, there is a planned part time pathway, specified each academic year. Please see the Programmes Booklet for pathway details.

- For the CertHE and FdA, lectures are on Mondays and Tuesdays throughout each academic year
- For the BA (Hons), lectures are on Mondays and Tuesdays throughout the academic year for the first four years. For years five and six, lectures will be on different weekdays, depending on the timetable
- Please note that BW1.2 (Communication Workshop) is a 3 day workshop and therefore will take place on days of the week beyond Monday and Tuesday. Communication workshops are normally offered during the January Reading Weeks and the month of July.

### Fees 2016/17

For part time undergraduate programmes, students normally take 60 credits per year. The fees for the 2016/17 academic year are as below; normally, there is an increase in fees of approximately 3-5% each year.

Part time students may book in for college lunches during term time via the meals booking in system. They will then be billed on a termly basis at the charge of £3 per lunch.

<sup>1</sup>The tuition fee includes the following:

- All tuition, including induction, teaching and admin support

- Regular group tutorial meeting for part time students
- Library and VLE facilities
- Internet access in the Academic Centre and all rooms in the Main Building

<sup>2</sup> Please note that fees are charged termly according to the credit rating of the modules you are taking that term. Module fees for the 2016/17 academic year are as follows; normally, there is an increase in fees of approximately 3-5% each year:

<sup>3</sup>Oak Hill College is an Associate College of Middlesex University. Its validated programmes have been developed, are delivered and assessed by the College; they are awarded and quality assured by Middlesex University. This means that our students are liable for registration fees. The registration fee is payable for two years of study on each programme. In practice, this normally means it is payable for:

- The first and second year of the two year part time CertHE
- The first and second year of the four year part time FdA
- The first and second year of the six year part time BA (Hons)
- N.B. Students who complete a qualification and then decide to enrol for further study on a higher qualification may incur a further registration fee

N.B. Spouses of part time students may audit modules up to 5 credits per term at no charge.
