Postgraduate Fees 2016/17

Fees for postgraduate students for the 2016/17 academic year are as below. Fees are payable each year; normally, there is an increase in fees of approximately 3-5% each year.

**Typically, college rental prices are approximately 70% of the local commercial rental rate. To maintain this, College reserves the right to increase rental charges each year within a range of 3%-10%.

¹PGCert: Please note that for formal registration and administrative purposes:

- Pathway A students will be registered as full time (*full time with reference to the PGCert means doing two modules in the same academic year and is not the same as being registered as a full time student on other Oak Hill programmes*)
- Pathway B students will be registered as part time

What does the tuition fee cover?

a) For the full time PGDip, MA, MTheol the tuition fee includes:

- All tuition, including induction, teaching and admin support
- Personal tutorials
- Fellowship Group
- Library and VLE facilities
- Study facilities
- Internet access in the Academic Centre, all rooms and flats in the Main Building and all single accommodation
- Meals during term time as follows
 - Single students: the fee includes breakfast and lunch each weekday during term time, and an allowance for evenings and weekends in the form of a minimal termly rebate
 - Married students: the fee includes lunch each weekday during term time

b) For the part time PGDip, MA, the tuition fee includes:

- All tuition, including induction, teaching and admin support
- Library and VLE facilities
- Internet access in the Academic Centre and Main Building

N.B. Part time students may book in for college lunches during term time via the meals booking in system. They will then be billed on a termly basis at the charge of £3 per lunch.

c) For the PG Cert (both Pathway A and Pathway B), the tuition fee includes:

- All tuition, including induction, teaching and admin support
- Library and VLE facilities
- Internet access in the Academic Centre and Main Building

N.B. All PGCert students:

- May book in for college lunches during term time via the meals booking in system. They will then be billed on a termly basis at the charge of £3 per lunch
- Are part of the group for part time students who are overseen by a member of faculty (this is different to Fellowship Groups for full time students)
- Are not required to attend chapel
- Are not required to do a college job
- Are not eligible to apply for college accommodation
- Spouses of PGCert students may audit modules up to 5 credits per term (in each term that the student is studying) at no charge

How often is the registration fee payable?

Oak Hill College is an Associate College of Middlesex University. Its validated programmes have been developed, are delivered and assessed by the College; they are awarded and quality assured by Middlesex University. This means that our students are liable for registration fees. The registration fee is payable for two years of study on each programme. In practice, this normally means it is payable for:

- The first year of the full time MA or PGDip
- The first and second year of the two year part time MA or PGDip
- The third and fourth year of the full time MTheol (for 3rd year direct entry only)
- PGCert Pathway A : The first year of the PGCert if completed in one academic year
- PGCert Pathway B: The first and second year of the PGCert if completed over two academic years

When are fees payable?

a) PGDip, MA, MTheol: full time students

- Tuition fees
 - bills are issued after the start of the academic year and tuition fees are normally payable in two instalments in October and February
- College-owned accommodation
 - married students pay rent on a monthly basis
 - single students in term-time accommodation are billed for tuition and accommodation at the same time and the bill may be paid in two instalments in October and February
 - single students in 52 week accommodation receive a bill for tuition and term-time accommodation that is payable in October and February. The additional amount for 52 week accommodation (£1589) is payable in three instalments at the start of each vacation period

b) PGDip, MA: part time students

- Tuition fee bills are issued after the start of the academic year and tuition fees are normally payable in two instalments in October and February

c) PGCert Pathway A students

- Tuition fee bills are issued after the start of the academic year and tuition fees are normally payable in two instalments in October and February

d) PGCert Pathway B students

- The tuition fee will be charged for the term that you are taking your module in each year

Study options for spouses of full or part time students

- Spouses of full time students who also wish to study full time will be charged the normal full time fees
- Spouses of full time students who wish to study part time on an award programme will be charged half price for each module, and full price for the registration fee
- Spouses of full time students may credit modules for half price and audit modules at no charge
- Spouses of part time students may audit modules up to 5 credits per term at no charge
- For any full time study, part time study or crediting of individual modules, spouses need to apply separately and by the usual closing dates for receiving applications; registering for spouse auditing may be done just before or once at college
